What is Bullying?

- Bullying happens when individuals or group of people continues to hurt, frighten, threaten, or exclude another person on purpose. It's often a repeated activity, with a particular child singled out over and over again.
- Bullying involves an imbalance of power, where the child who bullies has more power (due to factors like age, size, or higher social status) than the targeted child.
- There's not just one profile of a child who is bullied—any child can be singled out for any reason.

Project Description:

T-Shirt Design

With a partner or on your own, you must create a t-shirt design, using the template provided. The design must illustrate one of the major concepts covered in the Steps to Respect curriculum. The T-shirt needs to be colorful and show that you put a great deal of thought into your design. You can use pictures, words, symbols, or a combination of these things to illustrate the Steps to Respect theme or concept. After break, we will transform your designs into real T-shirts. We will also have T-shirt design contest and the winner will receive 2 extra T-shirts with their design, to give to a parent or friend of your choice!

You will also include a 1-2 paragraph description about your T-shirt, why you chose your design, and why the theme/concept you chose is important. The typed description will be attached to your template and can be neatly handwritten or typed. The t-shirt needs to be neat, colorful, and most importantly, CREATIVE!
